- ◆ Past events include suicide awareness, racial justice, youth programming.



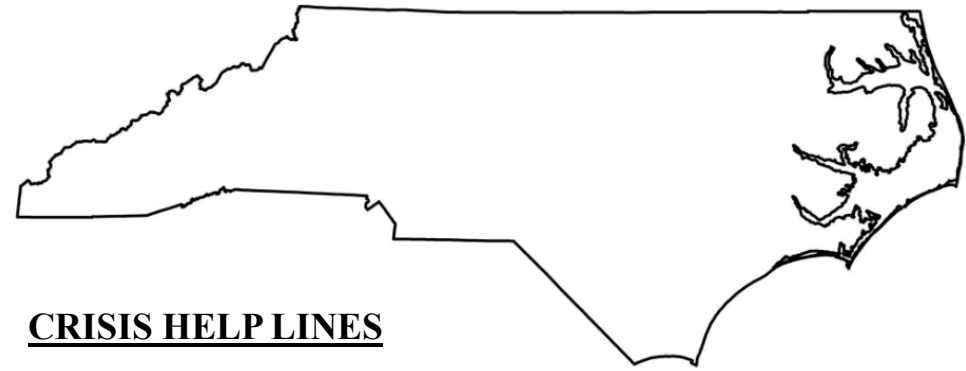

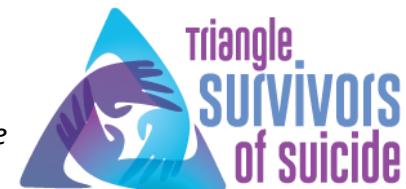
